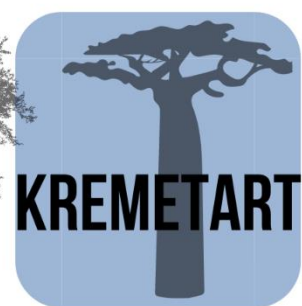
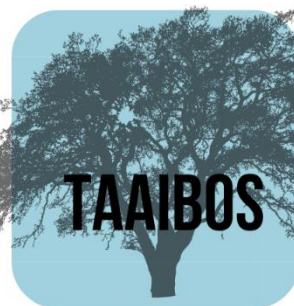

INFORMATION TO HOSTEL PARENTS

It is a pleasure to extend a hearty word of welcome to each hostel parent at Ligbron. From now on we will form a team in the interest of your child. Should there be any problem(s) whatsoever, feel free to come and discuss it with us at any time. We will always be there to help and advise you.

We are eagerly looking forward to making your child a part of our hostel family. Your child is going to be very happy with us. You must realise that any changes one makes in life are not easy at all. They might find it very difficult during the first term, but do not despair. It will get better as time goes by, and pretty soon they will feel a definite part of the "Liggie" team. Initiation does not take place at all, but instead the Learner Management Team will welcome them, by means of an orientation programme.

Parents should please take note of the following rules in order to maintain the necessary discipline.

- Parents must immediately notify the senior house master in the case of any extra-ordinary arrangements concerning your child/children, at ALL times.
- Should your child/children not return after having gone home for the weekend, please notify us immediately (e.g. due to sickness).
- All learners must go home over weekends. Only if the learner is participating in a sports' meeting over a weekend, he/ she will be able to stay in. This will be free of charge.
- Only if a special arrangement has been made with the Head of the Hostel, will it be possible to stay in over a weekend, at a fee of R200 per weekend. These learners must sign in at the Kitchen on the Thursday before the weekend.
- If a learner returns on a Sunday, the Hostel teacher must be informed for roll-call purposes.
- If a learner needs medical attention during the week the staff will handle it in co-operation with you as parents.
- The costs of any damage to the hostel by a learner will be put on the account of the parent.
- Hostel rules are enclosed with this letter.
- Only learners who have been given 3 months' notice on leaving the hostel will receive discount on hostel fees. No accounts will be credited at short notice as in the case of matriculants who intend leaving the hostel during the last quarter.

We hope that your child's stay in the hostel will be pleasant at all times.

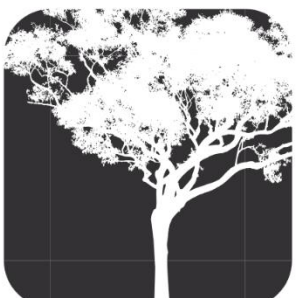

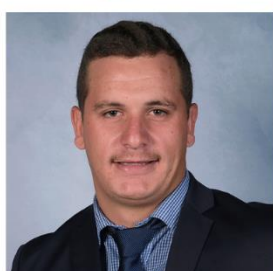

Find the route that suites you and reserve your spot by buying a bus ticket at the financial office.

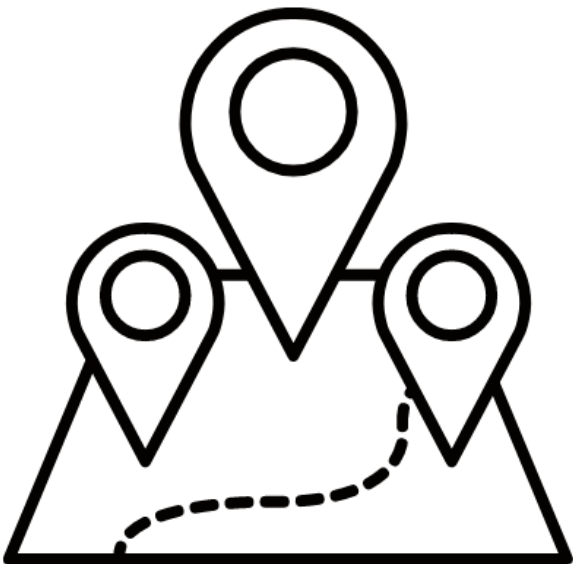
Busses depart on Friday at 13:15 from the parking area in front of the cricket academy.
